

## CLUB 4-VISIT PASS

This is a once-a-week, 4-visit pass, exclusively offered to our ski club members.

Weekly use resets on Mondays. Early Return Options are not applicable.

Please choose from the following options:

- 1) **\$0 : NO LESSONS:** You do not intend to take any lessons.
- 2) **\$40 ADDITIONAL: PROGRESSIVE LESSONS ADD-ON:** This adds on our four (4) 60 minute lesson series, beginning the week of January 9<sup>th</sup>, 2017 on your club's preselected day. Lesson times are 1:00PM, 4:00PM, 5PM, 6PM, 7PM and 8:00PM on the hour. Like anything, the more skilled you become, the more fun you will have and the more safely you can enjoy the activity! We will place you in with a group of people with similar abilities.

*Whether skiing or snowboarding, please note a description of level 1 through 9 as listed below:*

**LEVEL ONE:** You are brand new to the sport and have never skied or snowboarded.

**LEVEL TWO:** You are a cautious novice. You are able to stop on beginner terrain, but have trouble linking turns. You may have skied or snowboarded once or twice before. *You feel comfortable in the beginner area and Green Chair.*

**LEVEL THREE:** You are a comfortable novice. You are able to stop and make round turns on beginner terrain. *You feel comfortable on Green Chair and Farside.*

**LEVEL FOUR:** You are a cautious intermediate. As a skier, you are starting to make parallel turns, but are uncomfortable with speed. As a snowboarder you are linking turns on easier intermediate terrain, but are uncomfortable with speed. *You are comfortable on the Blue Chair, Farside, Clyde's Super Slide, and Backstage.*

**LEVEL FIVE:** You are confident on easier blue terrain. As a skier, you are mostly skiing parallel except on icy or steep terrain. As a snowboarder, you are linking turns except on icy or steep terrain. *You are comfortable on all blue terrain (Runway, Tuff Enuff, Intermission, etc.)*

**LEVEL SIX:** You are taking the next steps to advanced terrain. You are linking turns cautiously on steep terrain. *You are comfortable on runs like Encore, Special Effects, and Intermission.*

**LEVEL SEVEN:** You have control of the speed and shape of your turn on all blue terrain. You can navigate all black diamond runs and are learning different snow types and terrain. *You are comfortable on Center Stage and Deception.*

**LEVEL EIGHT:** You are confident on all black diamond terrain in all conditions. You are able to ski or snowboard mogul covered terrain. *You are comfortable on all black diamond runs, in any condition.*

**LEVEL NINE:** You enjoy the challenge of difficult terrain such as moguls and steeps. You are comfortable and confident on all terrain, and are looking to improve technique. *You are comfortable on all runs, including double black diamonds like Hollywood.*

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## First Time Included Beginner Lessons

The First Time Included Beginner Lesson is strongly recommended for new skiers and snowboarders who are not taking the 4 weeks of Club Lessons. This lesson is included with every lift ticket purchased and will help participants learn to control speed and turn through terrain-based teaching techniques. First Time Lessons are 50 minutes long and are taught on the top of every hour. Lessons are limited to first time skiers and snowboarders.

## 2017 Club Lesson Add On Outline

By registering for the Club Lesson Add On, participants receive one hour lessons that fall on the preselected weekday for their club, for 4 consecutive weeks. Individuals will be grouped with skiers or snowboarders of the same or similar ability level. Instructors will work with the groups to improve their skills in the areas of balance, rotary, edging and pressure.

For the best learning experience, we strongly recommend that those taking the Club Lessons work on one discipline (skiing or snowboarding) for the 4 weeks of lessons.

**Start Date:** Week of January 9<sup>th</sup>, 2017  
**End Date:** Week of January 30<sup>th</sup>, 2017  
**Make Up Date:** Week of February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2017\*

*\*If an entire club (not individuals) misses their selected lesson day due to bussing, weather, school functions, etc. we will work with that club to accommodate their make-up lessons.*

**Lesson Times:** Club Lessons will be offered at 1PM, 4PM, 5PM, 6PM, 7PM and 8PM. Participants should arrive 10 minutes prior to their lesson time to be sorted into groups. Those who arrive late will be placed in a group for the following hour.

**Location:** Club Lessons will meet at the Learn To Turn Area on the snow near the West Lodge. Participants will be assigned a letter and will group with other participants at that letter each week.

**Minimum Age:** 9 Years Old
